Lent (Wednesday, 2/17 – Sunday, 4/4)

Lent is a 40-day period for believers to re-center their lives on Jesus Christ through fasting and prayer. Lent is traditionally observed by those in the Catholic faith as well as some liturgical churches, but anyone who is convicted to refocus and refine their faith could benefit from Lent.
